Runner's Information Sheet

Thank you for entering the 6th Anniversary Oktoberfest Road Race.

Packet Pickup / Registration - Packet pickup and Registration will be held from 7:30AM-8:45AM at Humpert Park on Alder Street in Mount Angel. Day of Race Registration is \$20.00 without a t-shirt. (Cotton t-shirts may be available for \$10.00, Technical t-shirts may be available for \$15.00).

Race Numbers - Pin the enclosed bib number to the front of your shirt. **DO NOT** put pins through the bottom tear-off section of your number. Do not remove or alter any portion of your race number until directed to do so by a race official. Race numbers are non transferable.

Finish Line - Enter the finish chute **ONLY ONCE** and keep moving forward towards the end of the chute. Remain in the order that you crossed the finish line. Allow race officials to remove your tear tag on the bib number to record your finish position.

****Notify finish chute volunteers if you ran an event distance other than the one you signed up to run.**

During the Run - While running on the course, be aware of automobile traffic. The roads on this course on **NOT** closed to traffic. Always run on the LEFT hand side of the road facing traffic, unless otherwise directed by a Race Official.

Restrooms - Portable restrooms are located at Humpert Park at the Start/Finish area. Restrooms are not available on the course.

Water - Water is available before the event, at the refreshment table and water will be available during the race - there will be 2 water stations along the 10k course and one water station along the 5k course.

Parking - Allow extra time as available parking fills quickly. You may have to park a few blocks from the Start/Finish area. There will be very limited parking directly in front of Humpert Park. Parking is best found on Alder Street (North of Humpert Park), Birch Street, Taylor Street or at Kennedy High School on Marquam St, only one block North of Humpert Park. Parking is also available on side roads and behind Humpert Park on Birch & Taylor Street.

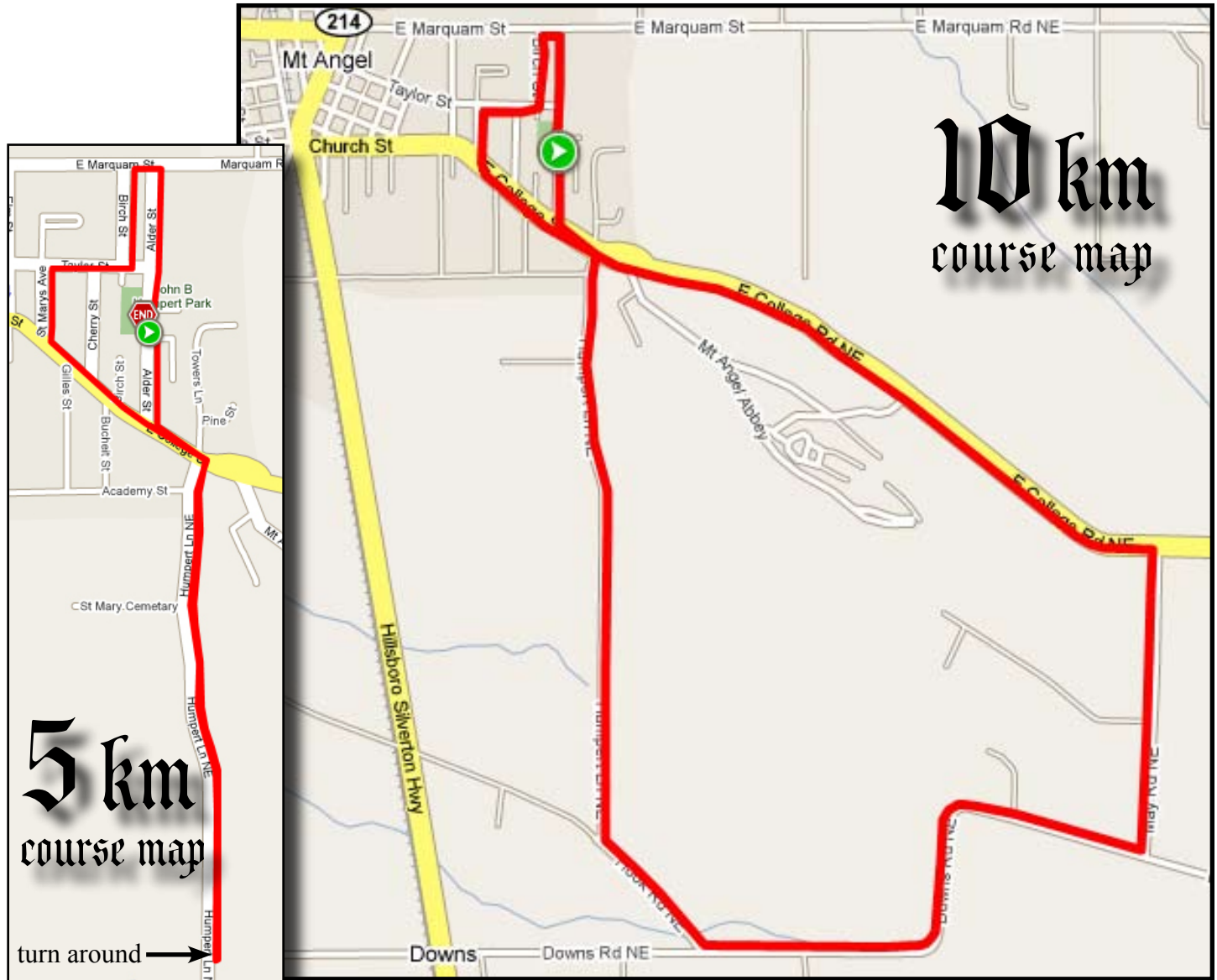
The START - The start is located on Alder Street. Please move to the starting area around 8:50AM. Line up in accordance with your projected pace. Swiftest at the front, please. Walkers and Strollers in back.

Changing Events - Please participate in the event you registered for. This distance is written on the bib number tear tag. If you change events, please notify a race official when you finish the race to ensure you are scored for the correct event.

First Aid - Race First Aid will be on call during the event. Your safety is our first concern - please run safely and run smart. If you feel dizzy or light-headed - STOP. Look for one of the course marshals.

Timing / Finish / Results - Only registered runners are allowed into the finishing chute. Please remove your headphones before crossing the finish line. Preliminary results will be posted on race day, at Humpert Park, at the conclusion of the awards ceremony. A link for online results can be found on the race website at: www.racenorthwest.com

Awards Ceremony - Will take place beginning around 10:30 a.m. Raffle prizes will be given away at this time. Please be patient for results and awards. We try hard to complete them in a timely fashion.



Directions -

From Portland heading South on I-5. Take Exit #282A onto HUBBARD CUTOFF RD NE toward Hubbard. Continue straight through Hubbard to Woodburn. Continue straight on Highway 99E (which becomes Pacific Highway). Turn Left on YOUNG ST (HWY 214). Bear onto SILVERTON AVE (HWY 214). Continue 6 miles to Mount Angel. Once in Mount Angel, Turn Left on MARQUAM ST. Turn Right on ALDER ST to Humpert Park.

From Eugene heading North on I-5. Take Keizer Exit #260. Turn Right onto CHEMAWA RD toward Silverton. Continue straight on CHEMAWA RD which becomes HAZELGREEN RD. Continue 8 miles. Turn Left on MOUNT ANGEL HIGHWAY. MOUNT ANGEL HIGHWAY becomes MAIN ST. Turn Right on CHURCH ST which becomes COLLEGE ST. Turn Left on ALDER ST to Humpert Park.
